Each grant applicant should write a one to two page proposal letter to the Foundation, describing the need for the funds, how the proposal meets the mission of the Foundation, and the plan for how disbursement of funds will be handled. The letter should explain the project objectives, operational procedures, time schedules, budget, and personal/financial resources available and needed.

As a general rule, the Foundation Board of Directors will not fund technology related grant requests for hardware related computer components. Grant requests for engineering/science related computer software, services, or training may be considered for funding should an exemplary justification for the request be submitted in the grant proposal. Other technology related requests will be considered at the discretion of the Board.

Scholarship related proposals will follow the A.O.E. Foundation's procedure for awarding funds. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college or university on behalf of the organization to the scholarship recipient. No funds will be disbursed to the organization or scholarship recipient for reimbursement.

Review of all proposals will be handled by the Foundation twice a year. Grant requests received October 1<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup> 11:59 pm EST will be reviewed by the Foundation in April. Grant requests received April 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup> 11:59 pm EST will be reviewed by the Foundation in October. Recipients can expect to be notified within 6-8 weeks of the grant review.

Grants made in one year do **NOT** imply continued funding in succeeding years.
